Jacquard and knitted fabrics for mattresses, mattress covers, pillows, toppers, baby car seats made of: cotton (also optical white), polyester, raw and dyed, graphene modified viscose (Graphene Inside the Future™), black color, cotton/flax, viscose, lyocell (Tencel®), polyamide covered with X-static® silver, polyester (Celliant®, Coolmax®), flame retardant polyester (Trevira® CS), raw, raw and mass-dyed polyester blended with carbon wire (Resistex® Carbon) and raw and mass-dyed polyester blended with copper wire (Resistex® Copper), and their blends; also with soft and antibacterial finishing (Sanitized® TH 22-27, Sanitized® T 11-15). Tridimensional knitted fabrics made of polyester/lyocell (art. Varioterm), dyed in grey color and finished with softener. Raw materials pre-certified according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® - partly finished with biological active products accepted by OEKO-TEX® - partly produced with fibres accepted by OEKO-TEX® having flame retardant properties and having biological active properties

The results of the inspection made according to STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX®, Annex 4, **product class I** have shown that the above mentioned goods meet the human-ecological requirements of the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® presently established in Annex 4 for baby articles.

The certified articles fulfil requirements of Annex XVII of REACH (incl. the use of azo colourants, nickel release, etc.), the American requirement regarding total content of lead in children's articles (CPSIA; with the exception of accessories made from glass) and of the Chinese standard GB 18401:2010 (labelling requirements were not verified).

The holder of the certificate, who has issued a conformity declaration according to ISO 17050-1, is under an obligation to use the STANDARD 100 by OEKO-TEX® mark only in conjunction with products that conform with the sample initially tested. The conformity is verified by audits.
